Guest Lecturer & Cellist Dr. Sae Rom Kwon

Dr. Sae Rom Kwon is an accomplished cellist and educator who earned her B.M. and M.M. degrees from the Eastman School of Music and a D.M.A. from the University of Cincinnati, College-Conservatory of Music (CCM). She is the winner of the Mendelssohn Fellowship, the American Protégé International Competition, and the Coleman Ensemble Competition.

Dr. Kwon currently serves as Associate Professor and Chair of the Department of Music at Kangnam University, where she continues to inspire students through both performance and teaching.



Dr. Hyo Jung Song received her M.M. from Seoul National University and both M.M. and G.P.D. from the Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University. She later earned her D.M.A. from the University of Cincinnati, College-Conservatory of Music (CCM). Dr. Song is currently an Adjunct Professor at Kangnam University and Yeungnam University, and is active as a collaborative pianist and chamber musician.
